Location

Date, Time, and Schedule

All regular Co-op classes will meet weekly on Tuesdays. Co-op classes will begin Tuesday, August 23 and will run until Tuesday, December 13. The final class schedule will be released by July 31. However, it is planned that most of the classes will take place between 8 AM and Noon. Although, depending on total participants, this may change to 8 AM to 4 PM.

Check List

There is certainly much to do when preparing for a new school year. So, how can you tell if you are prepared? For starters, make a list. To be helpful, here is a list of important steps in preparation for this year's Co-op.

- Fill out student application
 - Review mission, values, code of conduct, and doctrinal statement with your student
- Fill out teacher application (if you would like to teach or tutor)
- Sign up for classes (sign-ups will begin July 15th)
- Purchase curriculum and other needed material (contact the teacher for a full list of needed materials)

Grades

Although the coop is facilitating learning final grading is still at the discretion of the parents. Teachers may choose to grade work, but the final grade remains the parents responsibility.
